

Property Change Codes

DC (Description Clarification) – There was a change made to the legal description of the parcel which didn't involve a geometry change.

NA (New Parcel Annexed) – There was a new parcel number created for a parcel that was annexed to a different municipality.

NO (New Parcel Omitted) – A new parcel that was created but then was removed and no longer exists.

NP (New Parcel) – A new parcel was created from a recorded deed.

NPL (New Parcel Platted) – A new parcel was created from a recorded CSM or subdivision.

PC (Parent in Combination) – A parcel that has absorbed another parcel that was removed.

PLC (Parcel Line Change) – There was a boundary line change made between two or more parcels.

PS (Parcel Split) – The parcel was split into two or more parcels and is now a parent parcel.

RA (Removed Annexed) – The old existing parcel number that is removed when a parcel is annexed to a different municipality.

RC (Removed Combined) – A parcel that has been absorbed into another parcel and has been removed.

RPL (Removed Platted) – A parent parcel that has been platted over and has been split into numerous other child parcels from a CSM or subdivision and has been removed.

RH (Removed Highway) – A parcel that has been replaced by road right-of-way and has been removed.
